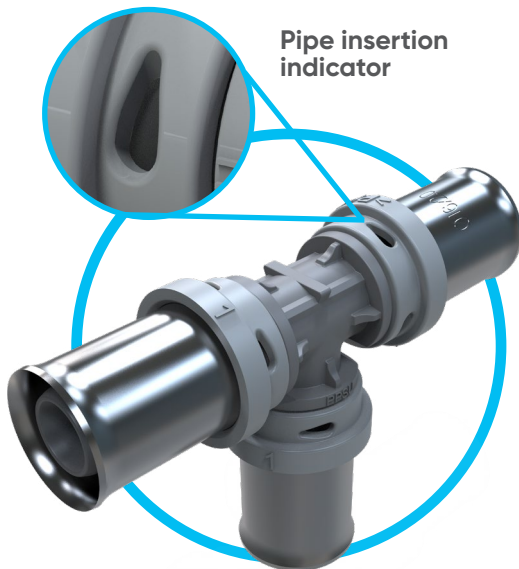
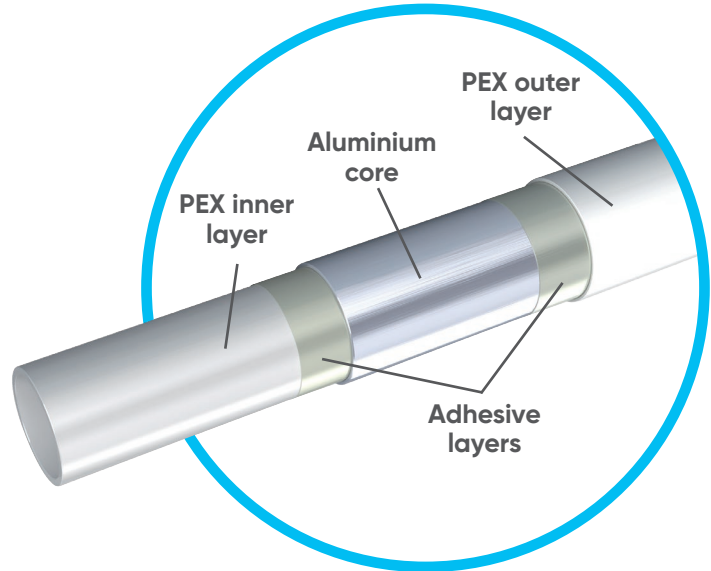

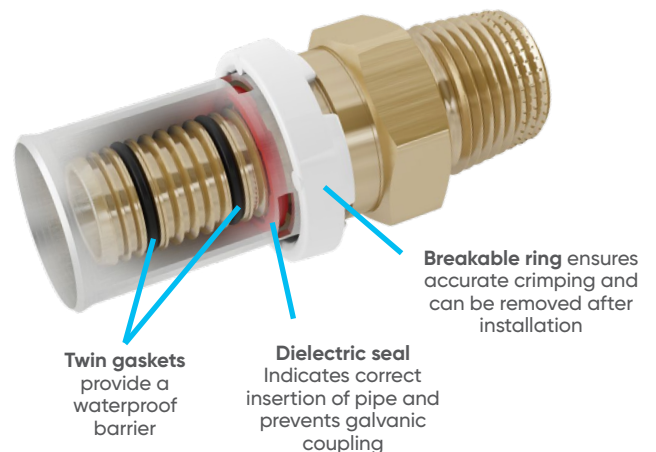


The next generation fitting...
